“2008 Yearbook Regulation A1(c) National ‘B’ permits clubs to invite 4 Regional Associations to an event, thereby restricting not only the number of associations but the number of championships that can fairly be invited/accepted. We are aware that non-race National ‘B’ events may be part of any number of championships providing the competitors are registered in the championships concerned.
“However we feel that this is unacceptable to competitors who are not registered in a championship, and also are not a member club of any of the invited associations, and who wish to compete on an event but, therefore cannot without either paying to register in a championship or npaying to join a club of an invited association.
“In the current climate of –
 - reducing entry levels, especially from the ‘club level’
 - competitors having reduced funds, and
 - the continual rising charges being put on member clubs – which have to be passed on to competitors,we should be seen to be doing everything to encourage competitor participation in events instead of the opposite.
“In conclusion we are not looking to events to be able to invite associations ad infinitum, but to recommend that the number be increased to 6 Regional Association invitations. (The 2 Recognised Groups or 3 Regional Associations and 1 Recognised Group could similarly be increased.)”
